Darin Headrick, Superintendent of Greensburg (KS) schools will be our Luncheon Keynote Speaker. Approximately ninety percent of Greensburg was destroyed by an F5 tornado on May 4, 2007. Mr. Headrick was instrumental in encouraging Greensburg citizens to rethink the town as a "green" town. Greensburg will celebrate a milestone in the town's rebuilding with the groundbreaking of their new school in August.
